

## **Welcome to Mount Marty University!**

### **What is the dual credit program?**

Dual credit courses are college-level courses taught by high school teachers who have been approved as adjunct faculty of Mount Marty University.

### **What are the benefits?**

This allows students to earn high school and college credits concurrently, at a fraction of the cost.

### **What are the costs?**

\$60 per credit hour.

Courses are 2 – 4 credit hours each; therefore, tuition will run \$120 - \$240 per course. Students are responsible for paying tuition by the billing due date.

### **What is the process for registration?**

If you would like to receive college credit for both semesters you must register separately for both the fall and spring classes during the dates listed below (unless otherwise indicated).

### **Drop/Withdraw**

Students must contact the registrar's office in order to drop or withdraw a course and must abide by the deadlines to drop as outlined in the academic calendar which can be found in the Undergraduate Catalog.
