## **Welcome to Mount Marty University!**

### What is the dual credit program?

Dual credit courses are college-level courses taught by high school teachers who have been approved as adjunct faculty of Mount Marty University.

#### What are the benefits?

This allows students to earn high school and college credits concurrently, at a fraction of the cost.

### What are the costs?

\$60 per credit hour.

Courses are 2 - 4 credit hours each; therefore, tuition will run \$120 -\$240 per course. Students are responsible for paying tuition by the billing due date.
