Carpet: It is not necessary to carpet your room. However, if you decide on carpet, we suggest you do not cut it until after you have arrived on campus and measured your room. Approximate size of most rooms in Corbey Hall (Women's Hall) is $16'10'' \times 11'6''$ and Whitby Hall (Men's Hall) is $17'5'' \times 11'7''$. Fire safety codes require jute backed carpet. All carpet must be installed without the use of tape or adhesives.

Washers, dryers, ironing boards, brooms, dust pans, microwaves, kitchenettes and TV lounges are available in each residence hall.

Cable services in the residence halls are available. There is an additional small fee to obtain a cable box from the IT department, which would be done following your arrival. Please communicate with your roommate to determine if you wish to rent one of these cable boxes.
