

## 2020-2021 Mount Marty College Verification Worksheet - V1



Your 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, Mount Marty College will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are any errors found, our office will electronically correct your FAFSA and the Federal Processor will inform you of the changes. If the correction(s) result in a change in your financial aid, our office will make the changes and update your award online. You and at least one parent (if dependent) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to our office. We may ask for additional information if more issues arise. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible, or within 30 days but no later than the end of the payment period so that your financial aid will not be delayed. Mount Marty College must review the requested information under the financial aid program rules (CFR Title 34, Part 668).
